Tiwi Design has an international reputation for working in a variety of media producing hand printed designs on fabric, etchings, wood block and lino prints, as well as ceramics and highly collectable bronze and glass sculptures.


11:30 Depart Tiwi Design and return to the airstrip for the next leg of the journey.
